

7. **Social Security Disability.** Plaintiff's request for Defendant to provide proof of all social security disability payments made to him including both past, present and all back payments received by him is **DENIED without prejudice.**

Defendant certifies that he has provided the requested information previously through counsel.

8. **Case Information Statement.** Plaintiff's request to require Defendant to provide copies of his 2019 and 2020 federal state tax returns with all supporting documentation including, but not limited to, W2's and 1099's within seven (7) days of the Court's Order is **DENIED without prejudice.**

The Court notes that Defendant has provided his current 2020 tax returns as well as the requested documentation in his motion.

9. **Litigant's Rights.** Plaintiff's request to enforce litigant's rights pursuant to paragraph 7 of the Order dated September 4, 2020, requiring Defendant to pay ½ of the following expenses for Max and Morgan within seven (7) days of the Court's Order or a \$75.00 per day sanction shall be imposed and Defendant shall be responsible for any and all attorney fees for any future motion to enforce is **GRANTED in part.**

Defendant was ordered to pay for 50% of all expenses for the parties' children, Max and Morgan in its September 2020 and November 2020 Orders. Plaintiff certifies that Defendant has not reimbursed her for said expenses despite notifying Defendant through Our Family Wizard. Plaintiff states that, at the time of filing, Defendant owes her \$1,825.50. Therefore, the Court **ORDERS** Defendant to reimburse Plaintiff within ninety (90) days of this Order's return date.

10. **College Expenses.** Plaintiff's request to enforce litigant's rights pursuant to paragraph 4(b) of the November 13, 2020 Order requiring Defendant to pay 59.30% of Bailey's
